



DM Youth *Leaders in the Community Scholarship* 2009

The DM Youth – Leaders in the Community Scholarship is awarded to select students in the Greater Toronto area who are leaders and role models in their schools and communities. We look to support young Hindu students who play an active role in the Hindu community and demonstrate a balanced life and commitment to post-secondary education.

Eligibility

Scholarship applications will be accepted from Southern Ontario students in their final year of high school who are planning to pursue a full-time public post-secondary education in Canada.

The Scholarship

Scholarship will be in the amount of \$1000 to be used to cover educational expenses incurred by recipient. Criteria for this scholarship are as follows.

- Applicant must obtain entry to an accredited post secondary institution within the province of Ontario.
- Applicant must be visibly active both within DM Youth/Devi Mandir and the GTA Hindu community at large.
- Applicant must have at least a B average when application is submitted (min. average of 70%).
- Scholarship funds must be used within one school year from the time of receipt.
- Recipient must remain an active member of the DM Youth/Devi Mandir community within a minimum of 2 years after using the entire amount of the scholarship.

How To Apply

1. Complete Application Form
2. Obtain most- recent official transcript of Grade 12
3. Obtain one (1) reference letter from a teacher.
4. Provide a Resume
5. Complete the essay (750 words)

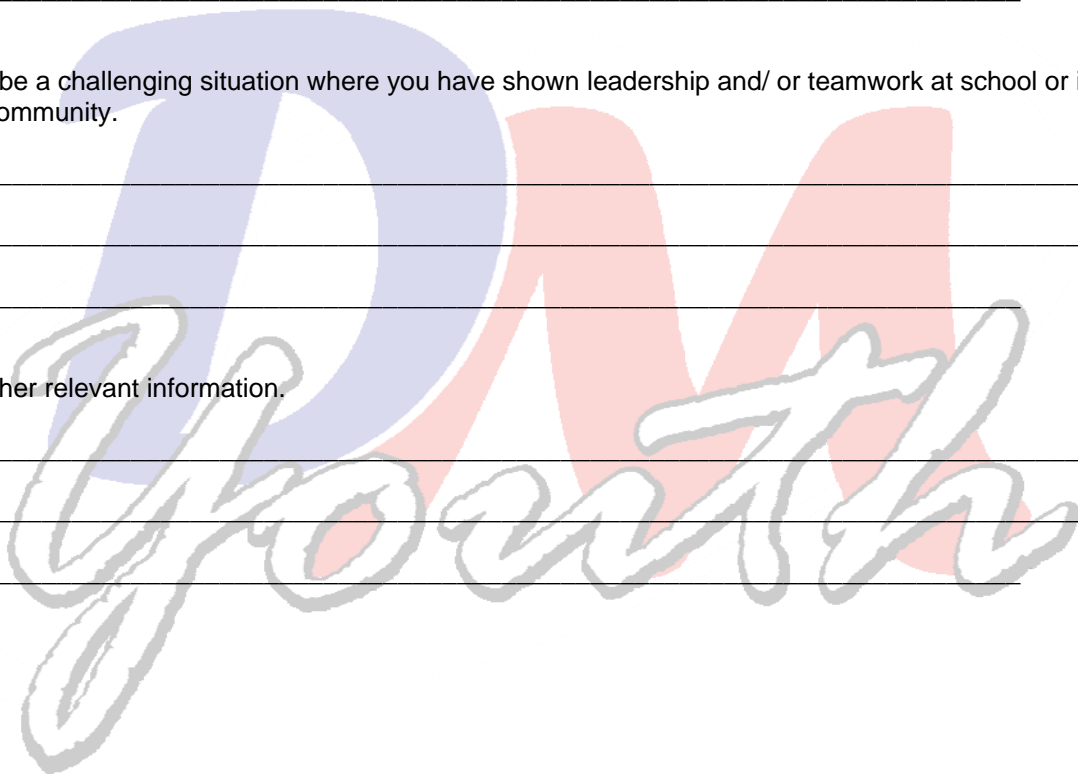
